The Walpole Police Department is seeking qualified candidates for the position of full-time police officer to serve and protect the citizens and visitors of Walpole, Massachusetts. The Town of Walpole is a picturesque community located 13 miles south of downtown Boston boasting strong schools and hardworking residents with a population just over 24,000. It is an excellent community to live and work. The Walpole Police Department consists of a dedicated group of highly trained men and women committed to protecting and serving the community.

The Walpole Police Department offers a competitive salary with excellent benefits, including educational incentives that include pay increases of 10% for an associates degree, 20% bachelors degree and 25% masters degree.

Candidates must also meet the below minimum requirements/qualifications:

- Candidates must possess at least an Associate's Degree (or equivalent credits) from an accredited college/university, or possess a high school diploma/G.E.D. equivalent and have achieved veteran's status with the United States Armed Forces as defined by Massachusetts General Law.
- Candidates must obtain a valid Massachusetts driver's license on date of appointment.
- Candidates must have the ability to obtain a valid Massachusetts Class A license to Carry Firearms.
- Candidates must be at least 21 years of age on date of examination.
- Candidates must pass entrance examination with a score of 75 or above.
- In addition to passing the written examination, candidates must pass oral interviews.
- Candidates must have strong character and pass a thorough background investigation prior to employment.
- Note: No person, who has been convicted of a felony or any offense punishable under M.G.L. ch.94C (drug law violations); or has been convicted of a misdemeanor and has been confined to any jail or house of correction as punishment for said crime, M.G.L. ch.22C, §.14, will be considered for employment.
- Candidates must pass physical fitness test, medical examination and psychological examination.
- Candidates must be a United States citizen upon appointment to the Police Academy.
- Must be able to successfully pass an MPTC or equivalent Police Academy.
- In accordance with M.G.L. ch.22C, §.10, no officer or student officer appointed or hired after January 1, 1988 shall smoke any tobacco product.
